

TAVISTOCK-CELLE BIENNIAL ART EXHIBITION. 2010

Dear Friends,

In July 2010 we will once again take an art exhibition to Celle, our twin town, to continue a 50 year long tradition of art exchanges inspired by Norna Beadle, one of the founder members of the TGA.

As usual, we will feature artists from the TGA, supplemented from contributions from the 'Drawn to the Valley' Group and other interested local artists. We will need about 50 pictures, and there may be a selection if more are submitted.

The theme is 'Dartmoor/Devon Seasons'.

Most works are expected to be 2D, due to carriage and packing restrictions. Work may be in mounts or thin frames. If glazed, with protective card and bubble wrap.

There is no restriction on media, but be practical.

Handing in days are Monday 31st May and Friday 4th June 2010, between 10:00 and 4:00 at the Wharf. Leave your packaging loosely open in case we get too many and there has to be a selection panel.

All work should be labelled, priced, and for sale. Price up in Euros, add about 15% to cover the higher value of art in Europe. There will be a £5 submission fee per picture, to help with transport to Celle plus return by TNT packaging. All sales will be repaid to the artist, in £St. at the end of the exhibition.

It is up to the artist to insure their works if they wish. The Society of Amateur and professional Artist do a good deal for their members.

The exhibition venue will be the Ritterhalle opposite the new Rathaus, and I have posted photos on the Wharf's web site if you would like to see how it looks.

www.tavistockwharf.com then go to **Gallery** and scroll down. I have also posted the entry form there for those who wish to download it and bring it in with their entry.

Hanging will be on Thursday 24th June, with a grand opening on Sunday 27th June at 11:30 performed by the Oberbergermeister of Celle, the leader of the BBK Celle, and our representatives. The show will be open for three weeks, closing on Sunday 18th July. It will be stewarded by student volunteers from the Celle Gymnasium.

If you have work accepted for the exhibition then you are invited to come to Celle and enjoy their hospitality. You will be billeted free with a BBK artist's family, and should expect to be there for about four days. A knowledge of German is nice, but everyone speaks excellent English- often better than us! We always have a wonderful time! Do take a house warming present.

If you drive, Harwich ferry to the Hook of Holland, then via Enschede, Osnabruck, Hannover, Celle. A busy day's drive on mostly autobhans. Watch out for weary Polish truck drivers as it's the main route to Eastern Europe

Yvonne and I will take the work in our car, but if you wish to fly, there is a good reasonably priced service from Southampton to Hannover, details on the internet.

Let me know if you are flying, and I'll arrange for your hosts to pick you up from Hannover airport, which is about 45 minutes from Celle.

Looking forward to your support for a great exhibition.
